



WELCOME TO THE MAHJONG ROOM

The health and safety of Members and guests is our utmost priority. RSYC have taken all necessary precautions to ensure a safe and healthy environment for all to enjoy during your visit to the Club. All Members, guests and visitors are advised to take note and adhere to the following precautionary measures implemented at the Club.

A. WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE CLUB

- Take temperature and scan the SafeEntry QR code individually at the guardhouse when entering Republic of Singapore Yacht Club (RSYC) and wear a mask at all times.



- Members who feel unwell or display any symptoms of COVID-19 should seek medical assistance immediately. These cases will be recorded and monitored as part of Safe Management Measures.
- All members, guests and visitors must comply with the Government directives issued, including safe distancing measures of at least 1 meter apart at all times.

B. SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES IN MAHJONG ROOM

- Operating hours: 10am to 12 midnight.
- **Maximum capacity of the Mahjong Room will be 8 persons (2 tables) at any one time.**
- Persons below 18 years old are not allowed to enter or remain in the mahjong room, as per conditions 3 and 7 of the Schedule of the Common Gaming Houses (Private Bodies – Exemption Notification)
- Membership card must be shown upon booking for verification.
- Members may bring up to **3 guests** into Mahjong Room and signed the guests in.
- Members are to determine the exact number of hours they want to book and are required to provide the names and Membership numbers of his/her playing partners.
- **Masks must be worn at all times in the Mahjong Room**
- **Tables will be kept 3 metres apart from one another, no intermingling of mahjong players from other tables.**
- **Strictly no food and drinks to be consumed in the mahjong room.**
- Return the Mahjong Set to Front Office after playing for cleaning and sanitization
- All members leaving the Mahjong Room need to check out by scanning the QR code given by Front Office.
- The Club reserves the right to deny its use to those who flout the measures.
